- Q. Questions continue to be asked in regard to company policy on the height of heels allowed on shoes worn in manufacturing areas.
- There has been no change in our company rule concerning the height of heels on shoes to be worn in manufacturing areas. Open shoes with high heels are consider ed to be hazardous to the wearer under factory conditions. The only type of show authorized to be worn in manufacturing areas not requiring safety shoes is one with a closed toe and heel-a safe heel no higher than 1-1/2". This rule, recently reviewed by the Safety Committee, also applies to office employees needing access to factory areas, and must be observed by all employees.
