JOHN CROW, RETIRING FROM HIS POST AS MRD REGION F REGIONAL MANAGER (ENCINO, CALIFORNIA) COMMENTS ON "18 EXCITING YEARS"

"My 18 years with GE and MRD have been exciting ones and I am proud to have been a part of developments and successes which have been achieved."

These were the words of John Crow, MRD Region F Regional Manager, who is scheduled to retire on January 1, 1975. These years, adds John, have been most rewarding and beneficial.

"When I started in 1956," recalls John, "the first Progress Line had been introduced and, a few months later, channel guard was introduced. I remember one DSM made the observation that 'we don't need channel guard as it makes the unit too complex.'"

"Since then we have seen TPL, Porta-Mobil, MASTR PL, MASTR II, Personals, Command and Control Systems, Computer-Aided Dispatch Systems, the

Voter System, and many others."

John says he feels that MRD has "a most outstanding list of personnel in top management, at section and sub-section levels, and on down to the field sales and service personnel.
