Donald J. Meyers Named General Manager of MRPD...

Donald J. Meyers will become General Manager, Mobile Radio Products Department effective September 1, 1977. This was announced by Christopher T. Kastner, Vice President and General Manager, Communication Systems Business Division.

Don graduated from Georgetown University in 1952 and following a tour with the Navy, joined GE in 1956 on the MMP Program. He was with the Ordnance Department in Materials assignments for two years, then Manager-Production Control of the Capacitor Department. In 1962 he was made Manager-Shop Operations in the

Battery Business Section, and Manager-Manufacturing there in 1966; Manager-Manufacturing for the Capacitor Department in 1969; Product General Manager of the Electronic Capacitor Products Section in 1972. He was named General Manager-Specialty Transformer Business Department in 1975, and General Manager-Ballast and Specialty Transformer Business Department in 1976.

Don will spend much of the month of September between his new assignment and his last position of General Manager - Ballast and Specialty Control Business Department in Danville. Illinois. It is expected that he and his family will be moving to Lynchburg shortly after October 1.

"It's a mark of considerable accomplishment on his part," says Post Advisor Carlton Phillips of Lester Moorman's recent certification as an auto mechanic."
"It isn't easy."

Lester, whose father Lloyd works in incoming inspection here, was the first sign-up for the GE-sponsored Explorer Post, chartered in the spring of 1974, and is currently president of the organization. (He round trips more than 60 miles to attend post meetings.)

Certification came through



the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence, and must be renewed every five years.

Carlton says, "The automotive group of the GE Explorer

Post was begun to teach automotive mechanics to boys in the age group from 15-21.

'When I found that Central Virginia Community College was providing a program that could lead to certification as a mechanic, I took the course...in turn instructing Lester--using the course books, some other literature and hands-on experience to prepare him for the federally-administered tests."

As a result of certification and related experience in his father's garage, Lester is now employed full-time as an auto mechanic, according to Carlton, "but is still attending Post meetings... still studying...developing even greater skill in his chosen field."
